

Industrial Eligibility Calendar 2010-11

To begin the school year students in 7th, 8th, and 9th grade MUST have been promoted.

10th Grade – 5 Credits

11th Grade – 10 Credits or 5 Credits in preceding 12 Months

12th Grade – 15 Credits or 5 Credits in preceding 12 Months

If students do not qualify they may not participate until the end of the first grading period.

Eligibility and ineligibility begin at the end of the school day.

*First grading period ends October 1st

October 8th – Students become ineligible if they fail the 1st six weeks and eligible if they are passing all subjects the 1st six weeks.

October 22nd – 3 weeks Grades

October 29th – Students become eligible if they are passing three weeks.

*Second grading period ends November 12th

November 19th – Students become ineligible if they fail the 2nd six weeks and eligible if they are passing all subjects the 2nd six weeks.

December 3rd – 3 Weeks Grades

December 10th – Students become eligible if they are passing three weeks.

*Third grading period ends January 14th

January 21st – Students become ineligible if they fail the 3rd six weeks and eligible if they are passing all subjects the 3rd six weeks.

February 4th – 3 Weeks Grades

February 11th – Students become eligible if they are passing three weeks.

*Fourth grading period ends February 25th

March 4th – Students become ineligible if they fail the 4th six weeks and eligible if they are passing all subjects the 4th six weeks.

March 25th – 3 Weeks Grades

April 1st – Students become eligible if they are passing three weeks.

*Fifth grading period ends April 15th

April 22nd – Students become ineligible if they fail the 5th six weeks and eligible if they are passing all subjects the 5th six weeks.

May 6th – 3 Weeks Grades

May 16th – Students become eligible if they are passing three weeks.

All students are eligible after 3:30p.m.on December 17th, 2010 through 8:00a.m. January 3rd, 2011.

All students are eligible after 3:30p.m.on March 11th, 2010 through 8:00am March 21st, 2011.
